Jane Lincoln's Solo Exhibition *All About Color* at Kingston Gallery in November

BOSTON, MA, September 17, 2015 - Kingston Gallery is pleased to present *All About Color* by Jane Lincoln, an exhibition that, with this group of acrylic on paper paintings, demonstrates her ability to dive into a focused pursuit of color's elusive, chameleon-like qualities.

The works consist of horizontal bands of color that, as arranged, conjure optical vibrations and reflect tinted shadows onto the wall. Lincoln aims for the effects to surpass optics and influence emotions. She says, "*Mixing my own colors is vital to my process. I apply acrylic evenly to BFK Rives paper in larger proportions than I intend to use. This allows me to adjust each color physically until I perceive a provoking composition of colors.*" She hopes that, with a specific combination of intuition and calculation, the color relationships that emerge provide psychological insights to viewers.

ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Jane Lincoln's art focuses on the precision of color and the intrigue of color relationships. She has had thirty solo exhibitions and exhibited at over fifty museums and galleries. Her recent exhibitions include *An Abstract View*, Court House Cultural Center Galleries, Stuart, FL, and work at the Kentler International Drawing Space, Brooklyn, NY; Provincetown Art Association and Museum, Provincetown, MA; and Lord Hall Gallery, University of Maine, Orono, ME. She has a MFA from the Massachusetts College of Art and Design at the Fine Arts Work Center in Provincetown, MA. She has a BA from St. Lawrence University in Canton, New York. Her work is represented by Cove Gallery, Wellfleet, MA and Kentler International Drawing Space, Brooklyn, NY. She is an Associate Member of Kingston Gallery.

Kingston Gallery is an artist-run alternative space founded in 1982. The gallery is committed to exhibiting the work of established and emerging artists. It hosts one-person and group exhibitions by gallery members and provides exhibition
